Objective

This postdoctoral fellowship aims to encourage people with a doctorate to carry out research projects in the areas of interest of the [Research Chair on New Challenges of Economic Globalization](#) - the new challenges of economic globalization. In doing so, the selected candidate will contribute substantially to the development of knowledge from a legal or multidisciplinary perspective on these issues, as well as to their dissemination, at the interface between academia, government and business.

Salary

The postdoctoral fellowship is remunerated in the form of a gross salary of 50,000 CAD annually, to which are added benefits and vacations in accordance with the collective agreement in force. The contract is for a period of one year.

Start date

September 2, 2024

Postdoctoral internship opened to

- Canadian citizens
- Permanent residents
- International candidates

Eligibility criteria

- Anyone who holds, at the start date of the fellowship and for less than three years, a doctorate in international law, international economics, international politics, international multidisciplinary studies or any other discipline related to the scientific programming of the Research Chair.
- Selection will be based on the quality of the applications and the proposed research program. This research program must be in line with the axes of the chair and contribute to its mission.



Application submission

The application must include:

- A motivation letter of no more than two pages;
- A description of a maximum of five pages of the research project clearly demonstrating the links between the project and the research areas of the Chair;
- A letter of recommendation from the thesis supervisor, sent separately and directly by this person to the email address mentioned below;
- The doctoral diploma or the certificate of successful completion of the thesis defense, and a copy of the certificate of completion of the doctoral program, as well as all university transcripts, including the most recent;
- An up-to-date curriculum vitae.

Important note

The status of postdoctoral fellow at Université Laval is full-time. The internship cannot be completed remotely.

The candidate has to be proficient in French but can carry out their research in French or English.

For international applications, please note that hiring is conditional on the selected individual's right to work in Canada. Necessary steps will need to be taken with government authorities in this regard. Université Laval will be able to assist the selected individual with these procedures.

By submitting your application, you accept that it will be forwarded to a third party for evaluation (member of the Faculty community, partner or donor of the Faculty). Measures will be taken to protect your personal information.

It should be noted that the selection committee may decide not to award the fellowship if the applications received do not meet the eligibility or excellence criteria.
